Christopher John Jenner is founder and Chair of the ASEAN–UK Forum; Research Fellow, Corbett Centre for Maritime Policy Studies, King's College London; Research Fellow, Joint Services Command and Staff College, The Defence Academy of the United Kingdom; and Senior Fellow, Institute for China-America Studies. He holds Master of Studies and Doctor of Philosophy degrees in Modern History from the University of Oxford.
